Consider making enhancements that will boost your older car's value and make it more attractive to buyers without an astronomical investment. Some that may pay off include installing a backup camera or adding

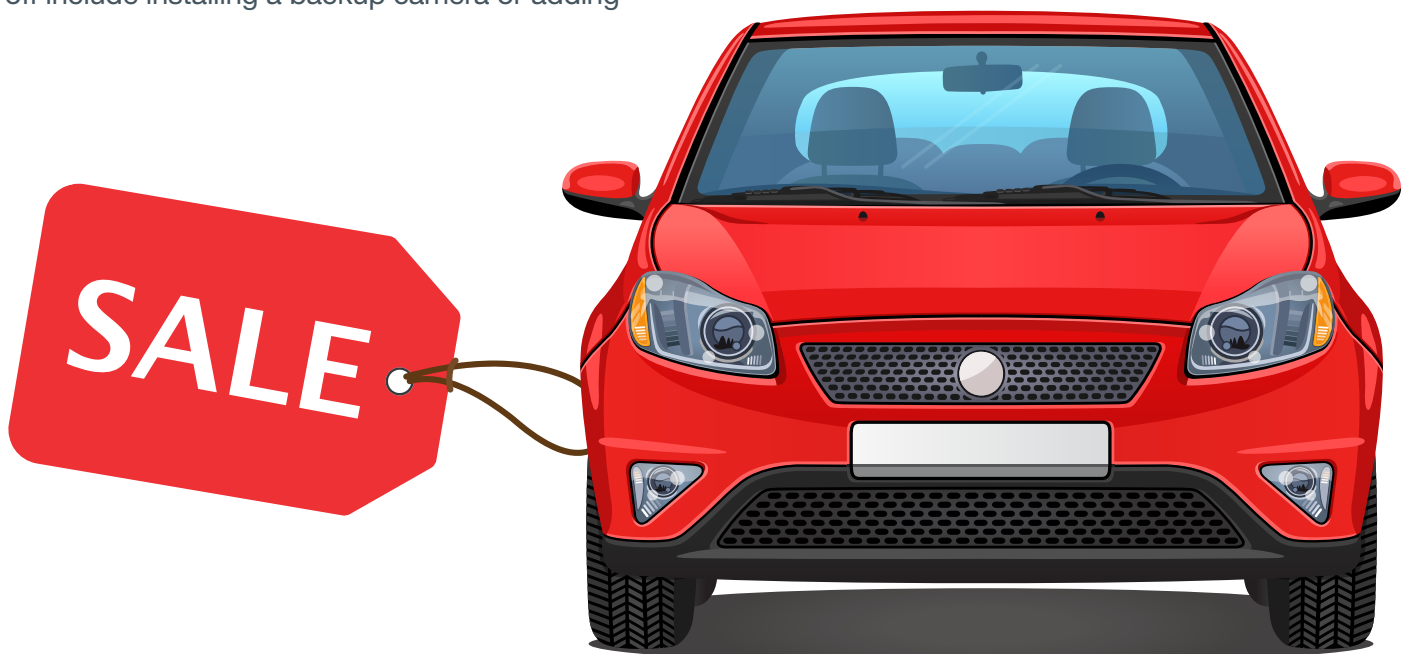
a Bluetooth-enabled system that connects to smartphones and allows drivers to listen to entertainment and take hands-free phone calls.

How to Be a Savvy Car Buyer

Whether you're buying a new or used vehicle, it pays to shop smart. This quick guide shares how to find the right car at a price point you won't regret.

1. Set—and stick to—your budget.

Going drastically in-debt for an expensive vehicle can set you up for financial ruin. It's important to determine what you can afford and keep that budget in mind as you search for vehicles that fit your wants and needs.

2. Expand your search.

Just as different dealerships have different vehicles on their lots, cars listed from one online site to another may vary. Compare what's available on Craigslist vs. CarMax vs. Autotrader vs. AutoList. Many private sellers list their cars on those sites, and so do most dealerships.

3. Check the car's history.

Request a vehicle history report from CARFAX or AutoCheck using the VIN (vehicle identification number). That will give you a detailed record of any serious accidents and other incidents, vehicle mileage, and ownership changes. Some reports even include the car's maintenance records.

4. Take a test drive.

Doing so will give you a sense for how the car drives and if you feel comfortable in it.

- Can you reach the controls easily?
- Do you have good visibility when driving and backing up?
- Does it have enough power to navigate hills?
- Are the brakes and steering responsive?
- Do you hear any strange noises or feel odd vibrations?

- Do you have enough leg room when driving or riding as a passenger?

5. Ask a mechanic to look it over.

Especially if buying from a private seller, ask a professional to inspect the car for any issues. That can give you peace of mind before you spend your hard-earned money and will help you avoid buying a car with potentially costly problems.

6. Negotiate the price.

Most sellers anticipate buyers will ask for a lower price. Prepare yourself with the knowledge you gained from the first six tips. That information—combined with a trade-in on your current vehicle (if applicable) and a favorable personal credit score—can give you leverage when negotiating a price.



INGREDIENTS:

- 1/2 Cup Mayonnaise

- Coleslaw above
- 8 small tortillas (corn or flour)
- Avocados (optional), cheese of choice, and lime wedges for serving



DIRECTIONS

1. Mix dressing ingredients
2. Toss some of the dressing (not all) with the cabbage. Save some to top the tacos.
3. Pat the shrimp dry with paper towels. Toss the shrimp in a small bowl with the spice mix to get it coated. Heat a drizzle of oil in a large skillet over medium high heat. Add the shrimp to the hot pan and saute for 5-8 minutes, flipping occasionally, until the shrimp are cooked through.
4. Assembly: for the prettiest and easiest-to-eat assembly go in this order: smashed avocado, slaw and shrimp. Finish with cheese, lime wedges, and extra sauce.
